





In 1928, Belgian surrealist René Magritte created a painting of a classic Lobacco pipe. Under the pipe, in cursive script, is written, 'Ceci n'est pas une pipe' (Figure 1, see p. 209). In this simple picture, which he called The Treachery of Images, he attempted to capture the paradox inherent in the distinction between an object and its representation: this was not a pipe, but rather, a depiction of a pipe. Perhaps unexpectedly, the issue of distinguishing between objects and their representations lies at the heart of some of the major issues that challenge scholarly publishing today, with far-reaching consequences for publishing innovations of the future.




